Curricular Planning Guide

This guide offers a recommended course sequence for students preparing for OT school. The courses listed indicate only the MINIMUM requirements for many OT schools and is not designed for any specific major. Students who plan to apply for OT school bear the ultimate responsibility of determining specific coursework required for their application and must fulfill the requirements for their degree and major in order to graduate.

¹ Statistics requirements vary by OT school. Verify requirements with the schools to which you plan to apply and with your academic advisor as to whether a course counts toward your degree and major requirements.

² Some OT schools accept BIO 2401 & 2402, which will not count toward a degree in a science major. Students should check with OT schools to which they plan to apply to determine which courses are accepted.

³ Many OT schools require Biomechanics (HP 2307) or Kinesiology (HP 2306) while some may require Physics (PHY 1405, 1408 or 1420). Students should check on the expectations of the schools to which they plan to apply.
